Dear Wendy:

Clear Ballot Group (CBG) requests a *de minimis* ECO review and approval from ProV&V for ClearVote 2.0 certified by the EAC, as well as ClearVote 2.1. The purpose of this ECO request is to ensure that the aforementioned ClearVote version releases address Windows O/S vulnerabilities presented in Emergency Directive 20-02 issued by the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), the details of which are available at https://cyber.dhs.gov/ed/20-02/ and the EAC's Memorandum 20-01: Windows Critical Update, issued by the EAC's Voting System Testing & Certification Program Director on January 17, 2020.

Over the past few months, CBG has undertaken extensive collaboration and cooperation with Microsoft regarding Windows O/S patching. This patch adds two system files to the installation to remediate the vulnerabilities described in Emergency Directive 20-02, including the Elliptic Curve Cryptography (ECC) validation vulnerability in the Windows CryptoAPI assigned CVE-2020-0601.



The installation process adds two items, "Security Update for Microsoft Windows (KB4556813)" and "Update for Microsoft Windows (KB4556940)", to the installed updates path. To confirm the installation is successful, a system user must:

- press the Windows key,
- search and click "View installed updates," then
- double check that these two files now appear on the computer.

For your review, please refer to the resource files supporting this application, which include CBG's **internal** test cases and revised upgrade process notes.

Please notify me if additional artifacts are necessary for your confirmation that this critical software update is *de minimis* as indicated in EAC Memorandum 20-01.
