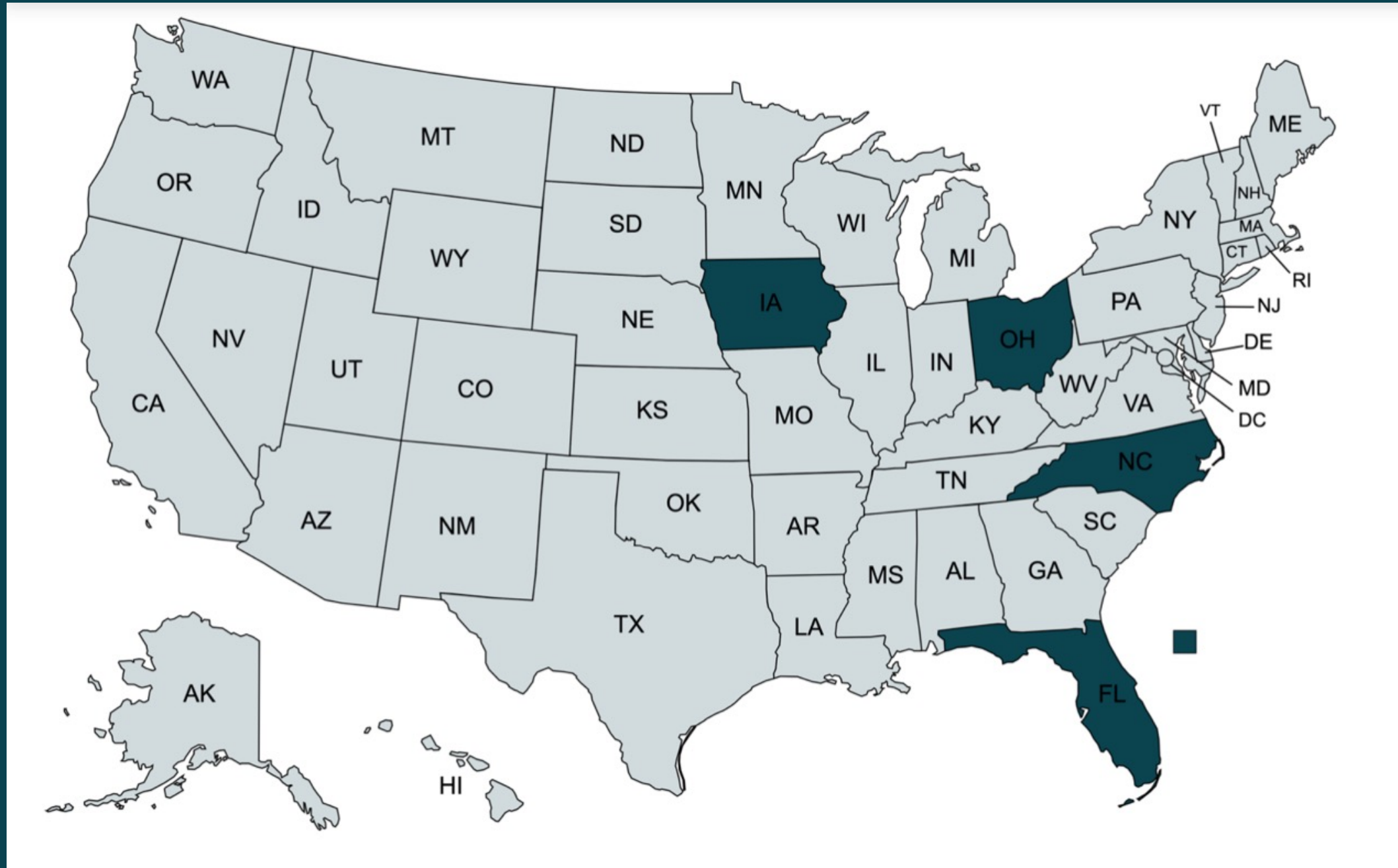

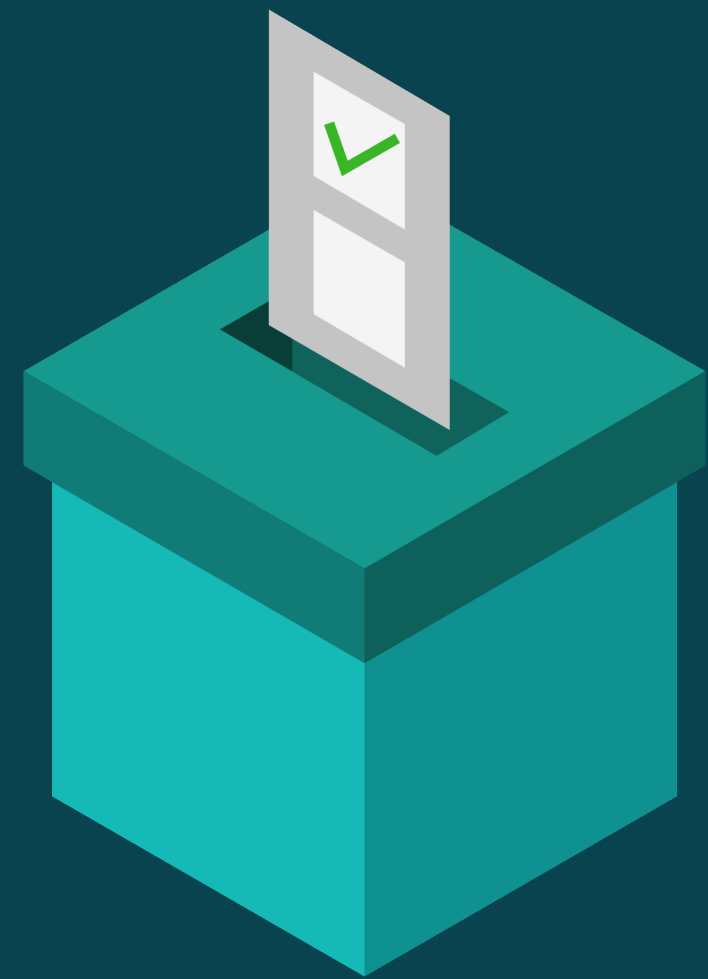

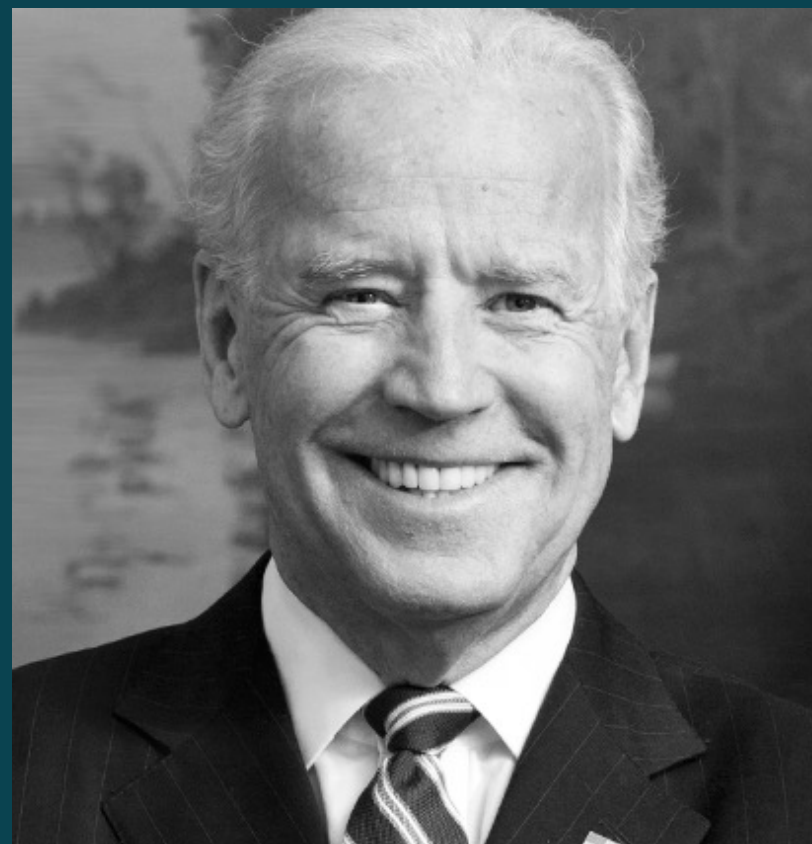

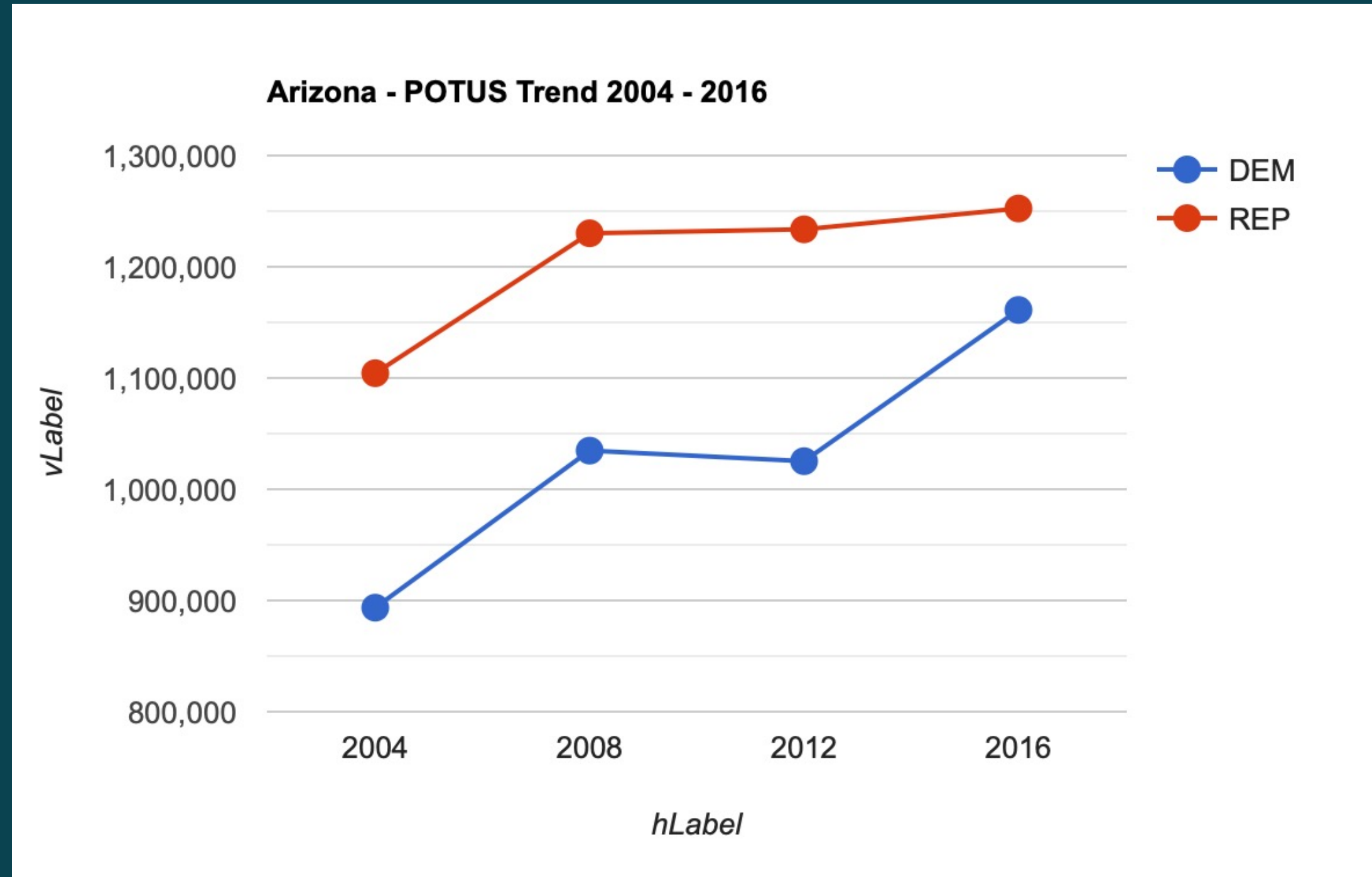

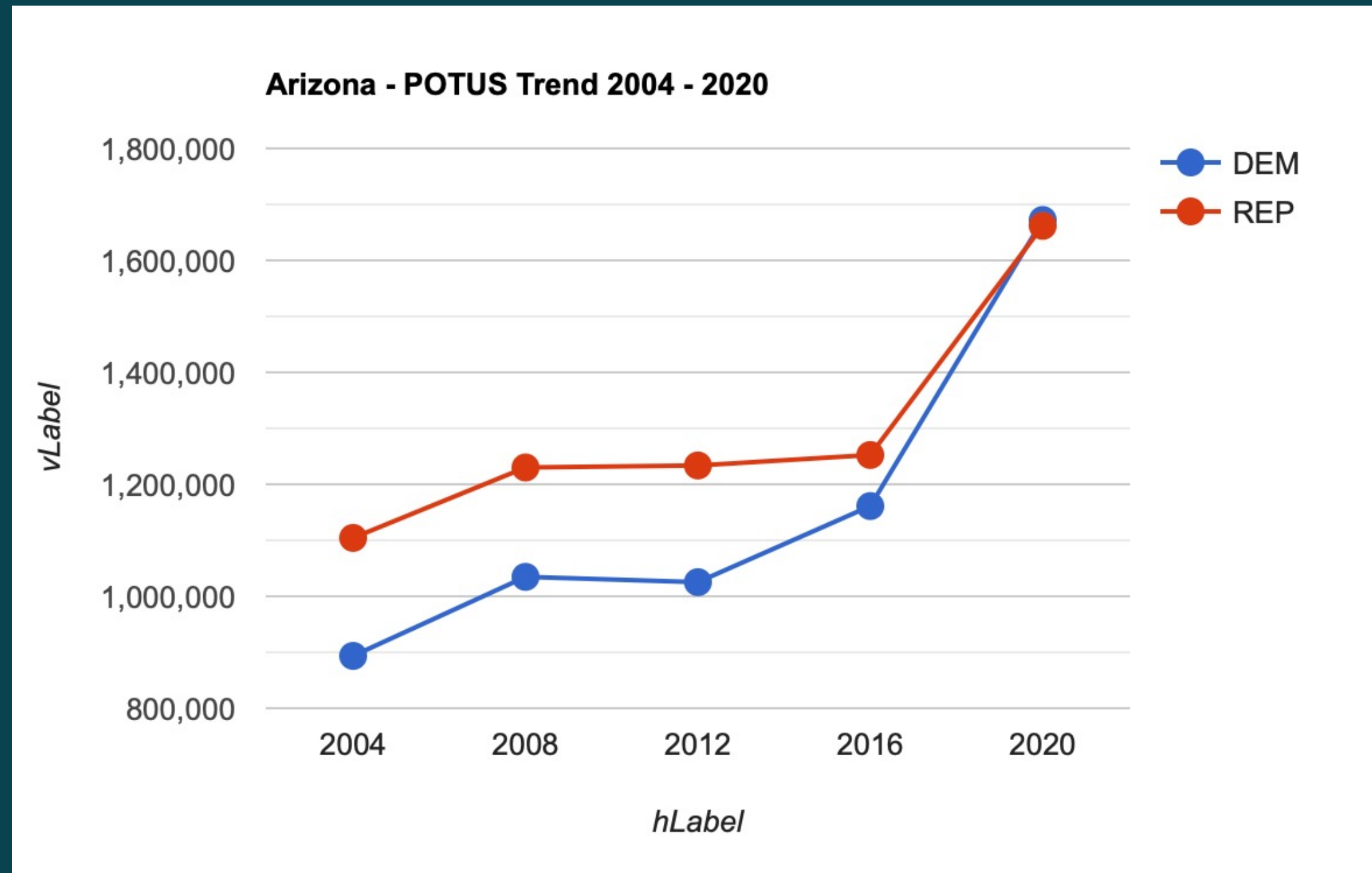
ARIZONA – 2004 to 2016



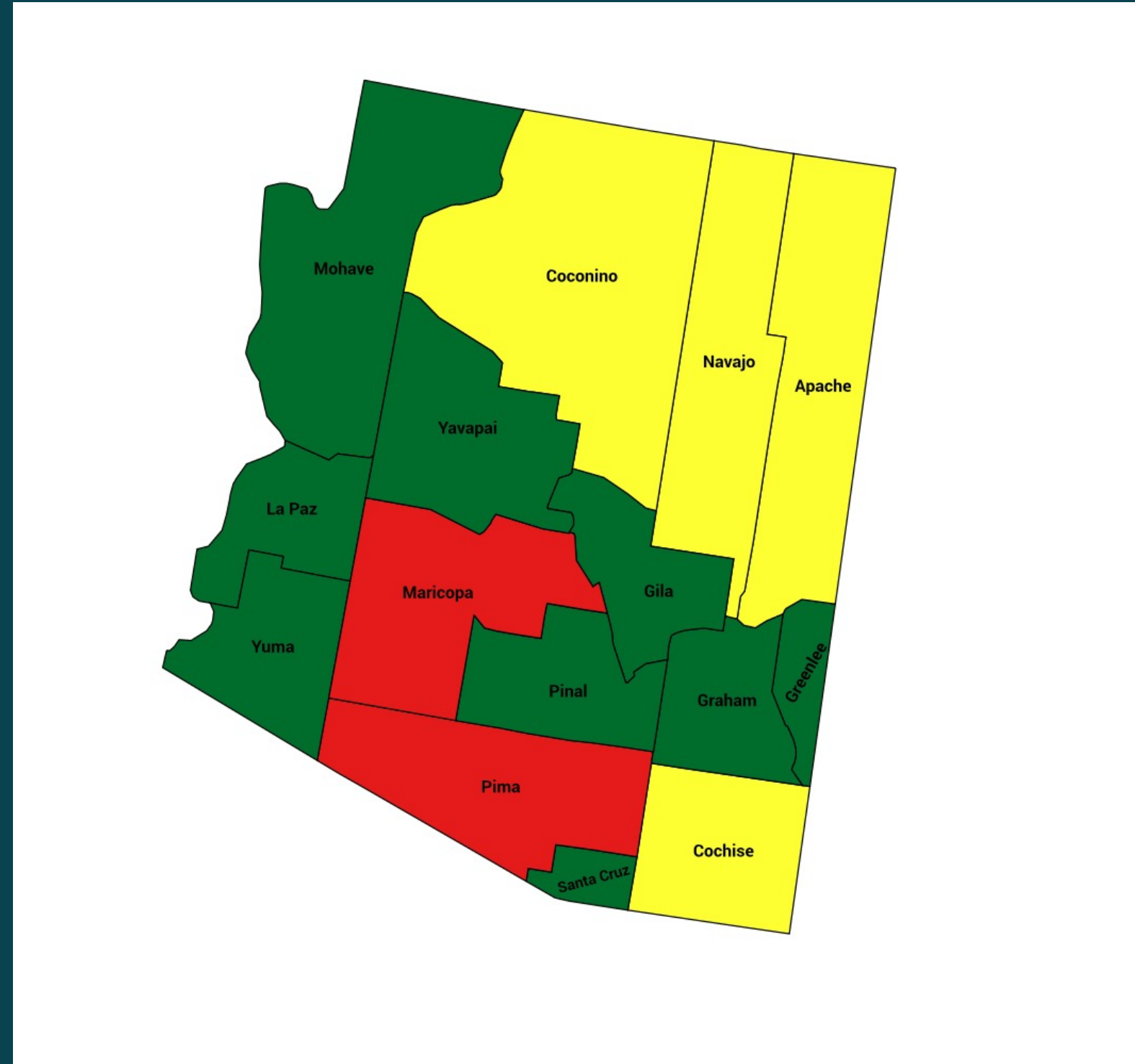

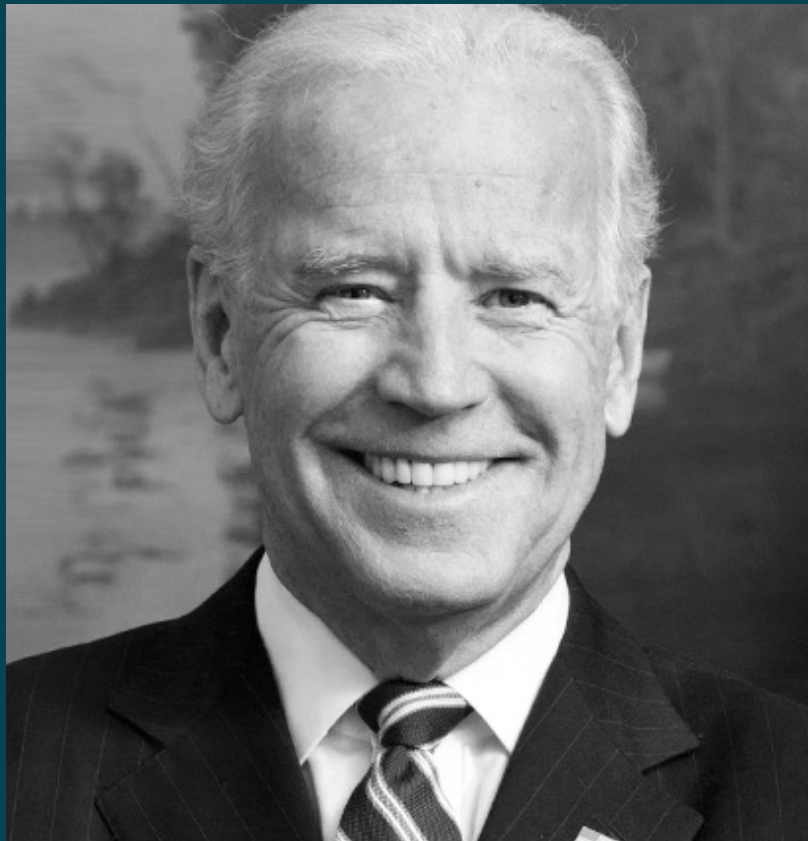

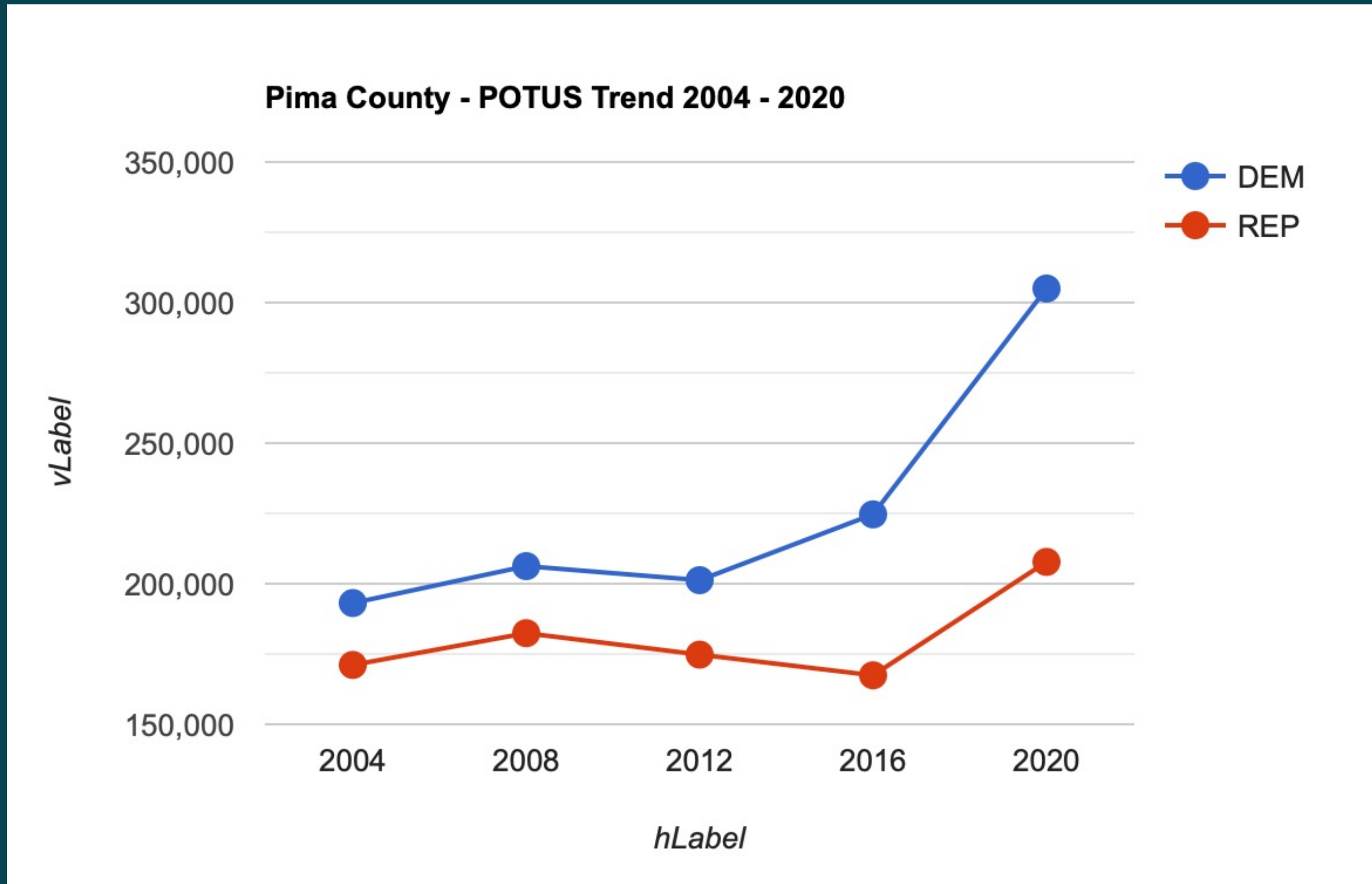

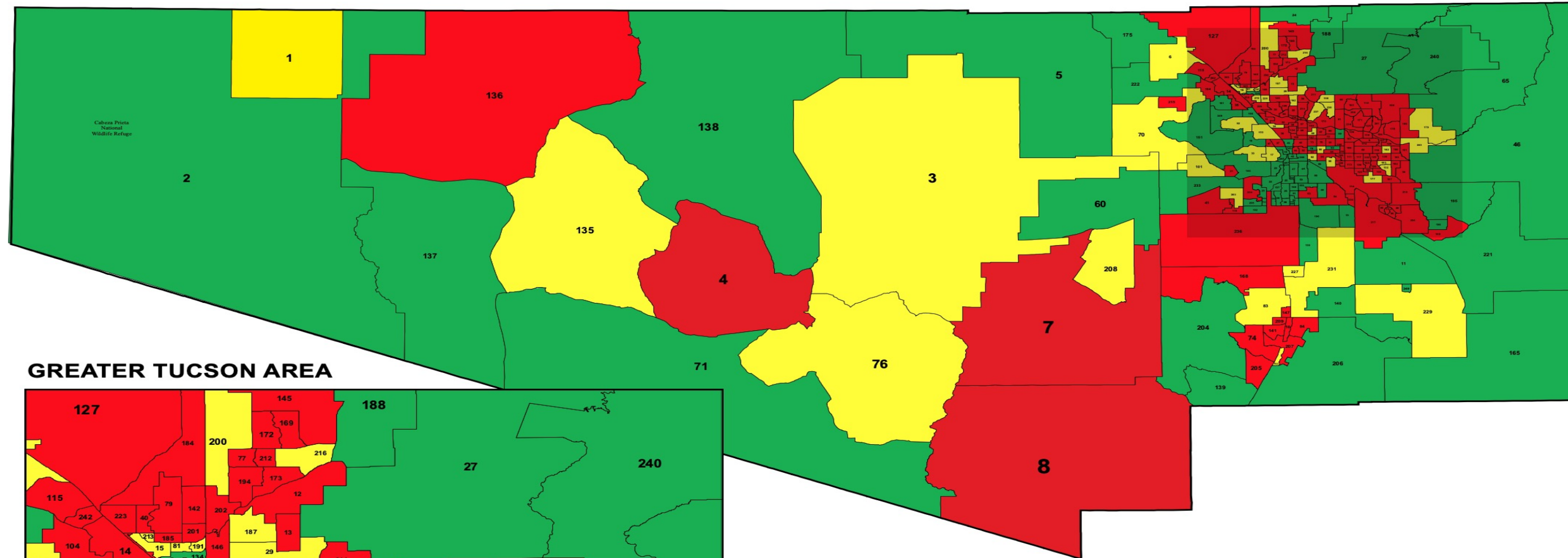

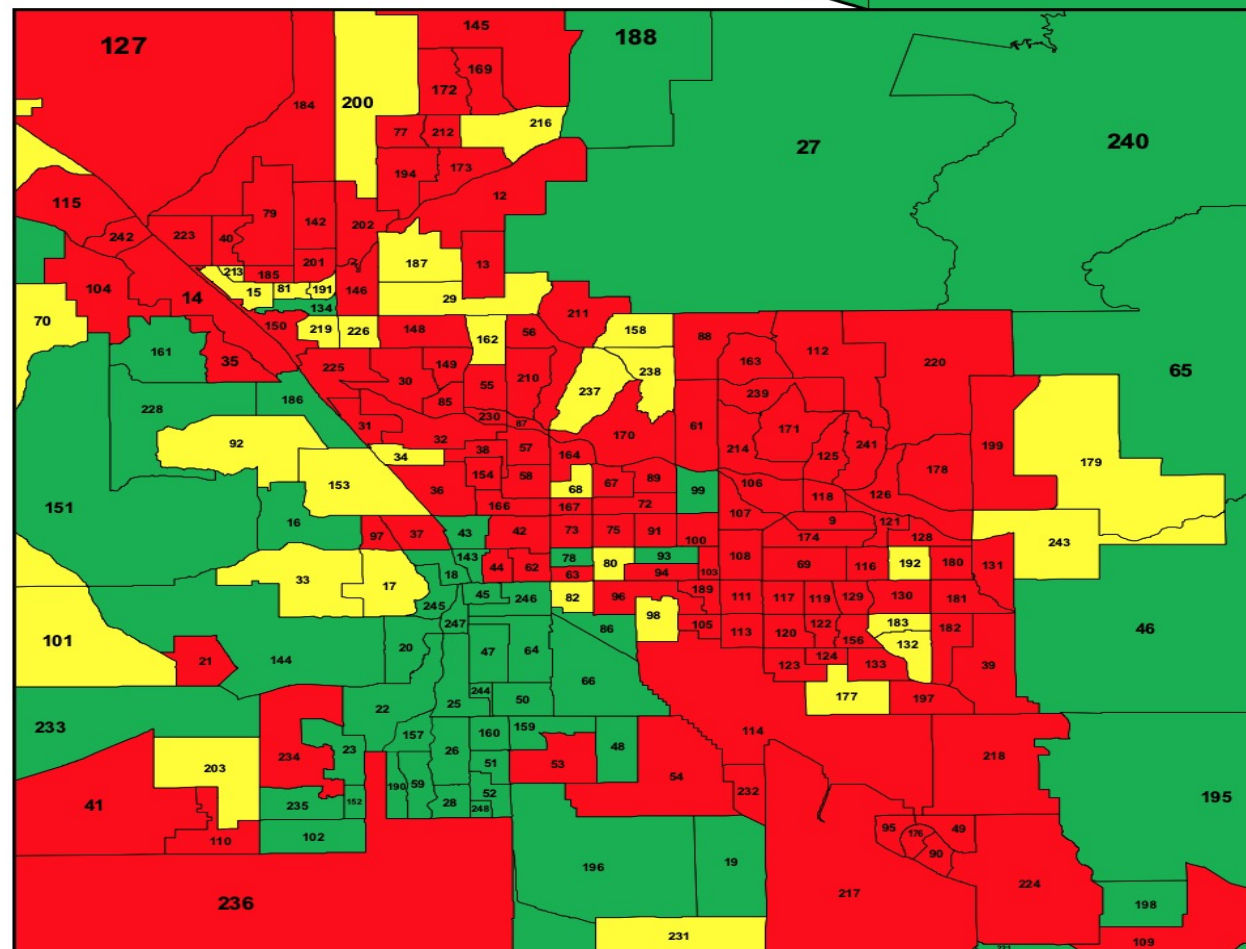


PIMA CO. - PRECINCT MAP
