Because the proposed amendment is not expected to result in any changes to the voter registration process in Florida, it will have no impact on state or local government costlier revenue. Further, it will have no effect on the state's economy. 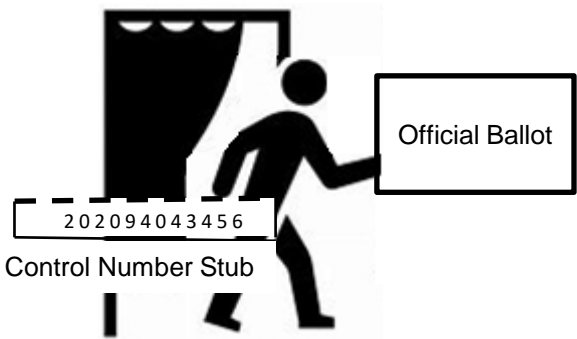

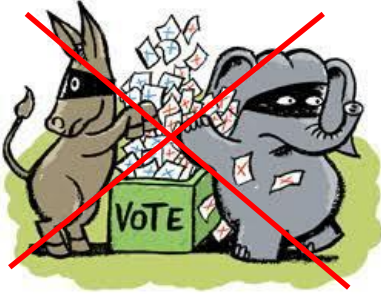

Advantages of Control Numbers on Ballots



Voter can check how their ballot was recorded



Thwarts counterfeit ballots



Stops photocopied ballots



Stops multiple scanning of the same ballot

Advantages of Control Numbers on Ballots



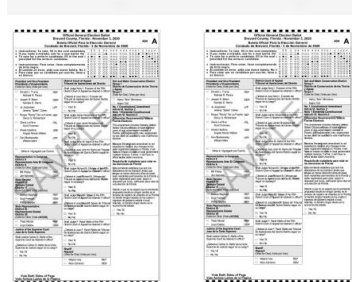
Thwarts improperly adjudicated ballots



No special paper required



Check against cyber manipulation of ballot tally



Allows 1-to-1 comparison of ballot hard copy to image
